
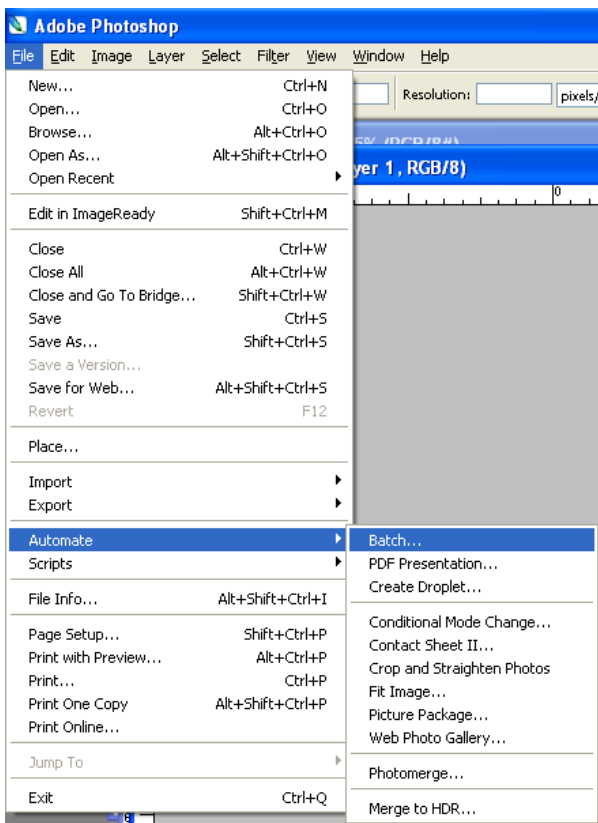


There are many pre-loaded Adobe actions in your actions palette, and you can load a bunch more through the Load Actions menu item in the Actions palette flyout menu.

Or, you can make your own actions and save your action set to use again.

Click here on the Actions Palette to get this menu to appear

To create your own action, Choose "New Action", then click record  to start recording the action. Everything you do gets recorded and appears in the listing for the action. Then just replay it to apply it to other photos or graphics.



You can open your files individually and play your actions on each file, or you can Batch them. Batching them basically sets Photoshop to opening the files, playing the action, saving the files and closing the files all by itself and is handy when you have a whole bunch of files to modify.

The batch dialog box asks you what files you want to open, what action you want to run, and how you want to save the files. It's a good idea to save the files in a separate folder instead of saving over them so you can keep your originals.
